CAPSID

IT IS COMPOSED OF PROTEIN SUBUNITS CALLED CAPSOMERES, WHICH ASSEMBLE INTO SPECIFIC SHAPES SUCH AS ICOSAHERAL, HELICAL, OR COMPLEX STRUCTURES DEPENDING ON THE VIRUS TYPE. THE CAPSID NOT ONLY SAFEGUARDS THE GENOME BUT ALSO FACILITATES ATTACHMENT AND ENTRY INTO HOST CELLS.

ENVELOPE

SOME VIRUSES POSSESS AN OUTER LIPID ENVELOPE DERIVED FROM THE HOST CELL MEMBRANE DURING VIRAL BUDDING. THIS ENVELOPE SURROUNDS THE CAPSID AND CONTAINS EMBEDDED VIRAL GLYCOPROTEINS ESSENTIAL FOR HOST RECOGNITION AND ENTRY. ENVELOPED VIRUSES ARE TYPICALLY MORE SENSITIVE TO ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS THAN NON-ENVELOPED VIRUSES.

SURFACE PROTEINS (SPIKES)

SURFACE PROTEINS OR SPIKES PROTRUDE FROM THE VIRAL ENVELOPE OR CAPSID AND PLAY A CRITICAL ROLE IN ATTACHING TO HOST CELL RECEPTORS. THESE PROTEINS DETERMINE HOST SPECIFICITY AND IMMUNE SYSTEM INTERACTIONS. IN LABELLED DIAGRAMS, THESE SPIKES ARE OFTEN PROMINENTLY INDICATED TO HIGHLIGHT THEIR IMPORTANCE IN VIRAL INFECTION MECHANISMS.

TYPES OF VIRUSES BASED ON STRUCTURAL DIFFERENCES

VIRUSES EXHIBIT DIVERSE STRUCTURAL FORMS THAT CAN BE CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD THROUGH A LABELLED DIAGRAM OF A VIRUS. HELICAL VIRUSES

ICOSAHEDRAL VIRUSES

COMPLEX VIRUSES

FUNCTIONS OF VIRAL COMPONENTS

REPLICATION AND ASSEMBLY

ONCE INSIDE THE HOST CELL, THE VIRAL GENOME DIRECTS THE SYNTHESIS OF VIRAL COMPONENTS. THE GENETIC MATERIAL CODES FOR THE PRODUCTION OF CAPSID PROTEINS, ENZYMES, AND OTHER FACTORS NECESSARY FOR REPLICATION. THE ASSEMBLY OF NEW VIRIONS OCCURS IN SPECIFIC CELLULAR LOCATIONS BEFORE THEY ARE RELEASED TO INFECT NEW CELLS.

IMMUNE EVASION

CERTAIN VIRAL COMPONENTS, ESPECIALLY ENVELOPE PROTEINS, HELP THE VIRUS EVADE THE HOST IMMUNE SYSTEM. FOR EXAMPLE, THE ENVELOPE CAN MASK VIRAL ANTIGENS OR ALTER IMMUNE RECOGNITION, ALLOWING THE VIRUS TO PERSIST AND REPLICATE WITHIN THE HOST.
